THE DETAILS SURROUNDING THE CRIME

On September 17th, 1999, Kenny Trive went missing. He never returned home from Green Bay's Preble High School, Wisconsin. He was known leaving school after his basketball practice. The other boys on his team account for his presence, and multiple teachers and students account for him standing outside the school exit, waiting for his mother to pick him up.

Multiple individual's testimony describe what some recognize as his mother's vehicle picking the boy up after he had been waiting. However, according to the mother's testimony, she was having a sick day, and did not go to work. Kenny Trive's older sister's testimony support the notion that the two were at home.

At around 3:00-4:00pm Kenny's mother went to go prepare to pickup Kenny. However, while she had her car keys still, she panicked when she saw her car was missing. It was soon after the the Kenny's mother called the school. After being notified that Kenny Trive had been seen being picked up in her car, she quickly called the police and contacted her local USIDN office about a missing person.
